

- I. Non-school personnel shall not interview a pupil in school unless the parents or guardian grant permission or the request comes from child protection as provided for in law.

- II. While the school's role shall not become identified with law enforcement, it has an obligation to cooperate and maintain a good working relationship with law enforcement authorities. In cases where parental or guardian contact has been attempted but not made the director or his designee shall use their judgment as to whether to let law enforcement interview a pupil.
